Fuerza Unida has the following programs:

Social Justice

Membership & Education: Fuerza Unida organizes monthly meetings to develop the capacity of our members.

Youth Leadership: This program is Summer long and provides the tools for young people to engage in the struggle for social, environmental and economic justice.

Environmental Justice

Food Pantry: This service provides food baskets to over 75 families on a monthly basis. This program promotes cooperation and mutual aid among our membership base thereby strengthening our ability to mobilize and take action.

Intergenerational Garden: The Fuerza Unida Garden was created by the young people in the summer program. Every year it grows with the sustenance of the new cohort of young people. This year we would like to invite adults to share their gardening experience.

Economic Justice

El Hilo de Justicia: The Sewing Cooperative is an alternative model for social, environmental and economic justice that provides a clean and safe job environment, a living wage, nurtures leadership development and business opportunities for women from the local area.

Fashion Show: The fashion show is in its first year of planning and will take place to support the growth and development of the sewing cooperative. The event will be a place where we will promote the work of the seamstresses.
